
Notable Events of April 2014

- April 17 Pursuit The Washington State Patrol advised of several hit-and-run collisions beginning on US 2 at the west end of town. Deputies attempted to stop the suspect vehicle in Sultan. The driver did not yield and his tires were spiked as he fled north and westbound. He was captured when a deputy used his patrol vehicle to spin the suspect vehicle off the roadway.
- April 25 Assault Deputies responded to a domestic violence incident in which a male struck a female on the head with a hammer. The female was transported via aid car for treatment. The male fled and was contacted by a police K-9 during our search for him. He was treated for the bite injury and booked into jail.
- Traffic Complaints/Enforcement Traffic complaints have been received regarding speeding traffic, failure to stop at stop signs, and various other violations at the following locations: 1st Street and Lewis Ave, 1st Street and May Creek Rd, May Creek Rd from 1st St to City Limit, Picklefarm Rd, and 164th St and Picklefarm Rd. Snohomish County reduced the size of its traffic enforcement unit in 2013 and 2014. Gold Bar deputies are picking up the slack in town. Gold Bar deputies have increased total traffic stops in the region by about 59% over this time last year, and in the city by about 107% over this time last year. I have directed deputies to respond to specific traffic complaints in Gold Bar with the intent to reduce violations during specific time periods and overall.
- Code Violations Tickets were issued at two Gold Bar addresses for code violations relating to junk vehicles, garbage collection and disposal, and recreational vehicles used as rental homes.

The following charts and tables compare calls for service in the reporting months to the same months in the previous year and provide a monthly average (Typical Month) in each category. Data displayed is for all dispatch groups provided service by the Gold Bar Region (KK) and Index (RR) police agencies. All statistics may be viewed at Gold Bar City Hall.


Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

Reports and Arrests Made





All Dispositions




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
