
Notable Events of February 2014

- Burglary and Vehicle Theft in the greater Skykomish and Snohomish Valley region are up. We are working a few leads that we are hopeful will precipitate the arrest and prosecution of persons responsible. February theft related activity was down in Gold Bar until this last week when we had reports of burglary and theft at various locations in town.
- I received a tip that a person outside of Gold Bar purchased and attempted to sell stolen property some months ago. Just a reminder that if the "deal" sounds too good to be true, it probably is. A rare item was purchased at pennies on the dollar from a person who is well known in the community where the purchaser lived for committing crimes of theft; and the purchaser then attempted to sell the item for several times what he/she paid. Another tip revealed person living in Gold Bar on 10th St purchases property from known burglars/thieves, suspecting it is stolen, and believes he/she can't be prosecuted for this. Receiving and/or selling stolen property, under circumstances that would lead a reasonable person to believe the property is stolen, is a crime and can lead to prosecution of the person doing so.
- Aggressive solicitors have been pestering residents in town for several months. They are using a tactic where they claim they are not selling anything and just want to demonstrate their Kirby product, then give the homeowner a coupon and information on where to contact them to buy the product. Since this is all clearly part of a sales pitch, they are soliciting and they are violating the city ordinance. Most complaints have either come in long after the solicitors left, or when no deputy was close enough to town to catch them. In one incident, they learned we were being called and left the area in a hurry. We encourage citizens to call right away, without tipping off the violators, if when they encounter public nuisance violations.
- Croft Ave, US 2, was blocked off for a police operation near 17th where shots had been fired and 911 was called. One person was taken into custody but was released to hospital care when it was determined that he could not be medically cleared for booking into jail. No one was seriously injured in this incident.


Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

Reports and Arrests Made





All Dispositions




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
