Index

Deputies are responding to reports of vehicle prowls/break-ins near and in town as the trailheads are once again busy. Several that we are aware of were not reported by the victims.

We have contacted the property owner on Index Ave regarding the van and he said he would take steps to get it removed. Deputy Griner contacted the former renter who also said he was attempting to get it removed. We will continue to work to get it removed from Index.

Gold Bar

Deputies responded to an assault complaint on 10th Street. A woman in the mobile home park had been stabbed repeatedly with a knife. She was transported to the hospital where, at last known report, she was in serious condition. A man was arrested and booked into jail for felony assault.

Deputies responded to a complaint of a motorcyclist eluding a pursuing police vehicle on 1st Street. The vehicle was seen speeding in Startup and on Hwy 2 and fled from a deputy when an attempt was made to stop the motorcyclist on 1st Street for speeding. The motorcyclist fled from a second deputy at 17th Street and Amanda. In the interest of immediate public safety, no actual pursuit was attempted once it was clear the motorcyclist was intentionally fleeing from police. The motorcyclist was not located despite an extensive search involving multiple law enforcement units. Anyone with information that may assist to identify the motorcyclist should be reported by calling 911.

A man was arrested for assault on 1st Street when he held a make-shift weapon to the throat of a family member and threatened his life.



Region

Deputies investigated a missing person report for a man last seen near the Skykomish River on the South Fork. About a week later, the man was found deceased in the river near Canyon Falls. The circumstances surrounding his death are under investigation.

A woman was arrested for assault with a weapon on Dorman Rd when she threatened a family member at knife point and took off with a child. The child was not injured.


Deputies investigated a threatening message left at Camp Houston by a Shoreline man.




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
