Notable Events of May 2014

Index

- Disturbance: A Subject on Index Ave was involved in a disturbance with a neighbor. This was determined to stem from a dispute between neighboring renters and they were referred to their landlord for resolution.
- Vandalism: A van was tagged with an offensive term at one of the above properties.
- Disturbance: One of the above persons was involved in a disturbance with a Gold Bar man.
- All three above incidents lack sufficient information to support a criminal charge at this time.

- Deputies attempted to contact a group of campers near the Index Wall without success. Deputy Ross posted their campsite with warning notices that they had stayed beyond allowed limits and the site was vacated.



Gold Bar

- Vehicle thefts and recoveries are up. A Dodge pickup was stolen from near 10th and Croft. A passenger car was recovered near the Mt. View Diner. Other vehicles stolen and/or recovered near town. No suspect is yet identified.
- Memorial day arrest: A vehicle was prowled just outside of town near the state park. A cell-phone locator app was used to track the suspect to a residence outside of town off of Picklefarm. The suspects had used the victim's debit cards at four locations in town before they were captured.

Region


- Amber Alert successful: Deputy Griner spotted the subject of an Amber Alert eastbound on Hwy 2 just east of Gold Bar. The kidnapped victim was still in the car with extreme concern the victim's safety should the suspect escape. The effort to end the chase safely involved Snohomish County Sheriff's Office, King County Sheriff's Office, Seattle PD, FBI, and Chelan County Sheriff's Office. The victim was rescued just east of the pass when the suspect's vehicle ran out of fuel.




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
