Notable Events of October 2013

Thefts from Vehicles: October yielded fewer of these in the Gold Bar/Index area than September and August but numbers increased significantly closer to and in Sultan. A person of interest has been identified in one vehicle prowl/theft just outside of town on Reiter Rd. Deputies are working with our detective to put this case together. Dispatch often codes a vehicle prowl, which is the act of entering a vehicle to commit a crime therein, as a theft. Most of the thefts reported are vehicle prowls. The combined total for both type codes is 14 for the month of October for our region and most occurred at trailhead parking lots off US 2 and Reiter Rd.

White Van: The driver of the white van was contacted by Deputy J. Cook. Following their discussion, the young man took the deputy's advice and left Gold Bar. He was contacted shortly after in the Lake Stevens area, then in Everett. To our knowledge, he has not returned and his departure coincides with a brief reduction in theft crimes in Gold Bar.


Burglars: There are still several burglars working the Sky Valley and Snohomish areas. Two recent burglaries, one east of us and one west, involved the theft of several firearms. Evidence from both crime scenes is promising but no suspect information is available in these crimes.

Squatters: October yielded several reports of squatters at various locations in and near Gold Bar. We continue to work to resolve this problem.

The following charts and tables compare calls for service in the reporting months to the same months in the previous year and provide a monthly average (Typical Month) in each category. Data displayed is for all dispatch groups provided service by the Gold Bar Region (KK) and Index (RR) police agencies. All statistics may be viewed at Gold Bar City Hall.


Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

Reports and Arrests Made





All Dispositions




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
