Notable Events of September 2013

Suspicious Persons/Vehicles: There have been various suspicious persons and/or vehicles observed by citizens, some reported and some not. One, not reported until I interviewed a witness on an unrelated matter, then went door to door looking for witnesses to the week old incident, resulted in solving a burglary in which 13 solid gold and silver coins, valued at an approximate \$19,000 total, were stolen from a county residence by a Gold Bar man who was showing them off in town. The coins were not recoverable.

A male and female subject, occupying a white Ford van with their two pit-bull type dogs, have been reported several times in and near town for suspicious behaviors. On several sightings, they had several teens hanging around. One burglary and a few thefts have been reported that occurred similarly in time and location with some of these sightings. At least one of the several subjects associated with this vehicle may be associated with shoplifting from the Family Grocer.

Suspicious vehicles and/or persons should be reported to 911 right away.

Burglaries: Several burglaries were reported, a few of which were residential. Three of the burglaries are of the same business where subjects cut through the fence to steal portable sawmills but were not successful at getting away with the loot. Not all of these can be said to match up with sightings of the white Ford van.

A party/noise complaint turned to a shots-fired complaint as deputies were en route, and then to a burglary complaint when investigating deputies learned that a male person burg'd an occupied home and the female resident fired one shot, causing the burglar to flee. One intoxicated male was detained for questioning and released.


Drug activity: Residents have reported discarded drug paraphernalia, including used needles, under the bridge north of 1st St and May Creek Rd, on the trail leading to the creek from Evergreen Way, and on the trail leading to Halls Lane from 19th St. A black Subaru was seen hanging around one of these areas with teens approaching and leaving the car on foot. This incident was reported days after the fact by a citizen being interviewed on an unrelated matter.

A male was arrested on an unrelated matter as he was meeting his probation officer on the street, and a bottle and baggie containing heroin were found on his person. He claimed that he picked them up off the street to turn them in, but made no effort to turn them over to his P.O. or to deputies until after the deputy discovered them while searching him following the arrest. He was booked for possession of heroin.

The following charts and tables compare calls for service in the reporting months to the same months in the previous year and provide a monthly average (Typical Month) in each category. Data displayed is for all dispatch groups provided service by the Gold Bar Region (KK) and Index (RR) police agencies. All statistics may be viewed at Gold Bar City Hall.


Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

Reports and Arrests Made




Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

All Dispositions




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
