### *Notable Events of October 2014*

#### *Gold Bar*

- Gold Bar Case Reports completed for: 3 Disturbances (no assault), 5 Assaults, 2 Thefts, 1 Vandalism, 2 Runaways, 1 Collision, 1 Warrant Arrest, 1 Mental Health Assist, 1 Agency Assist, 1 Protective Custody, 1 Death Investigation, and 1 Bomb complaint where the bomb was determined to be a fake.
- An object believed to be a pipe bomb was found on the front lawn and contained by a citizen who was picking up his children at Gold Bar Elementary School. Bomb Squad units collected the object and destroyed it, discovering that it was a fake. It is not known how it ended up in front of the school.
- Deputies investigated several assault and disturbance complaints involving homeless subjects frequenting private properties in and just outside Gold Bar. Deputies have identified a single male as the aggressor in these incidents.
- The new online crime reporting system deployed by the Sheriff's Office in recent months is working well. I am personally reviewing each of the reports that comes in for our region to determine the most appropriate course of action for our personnel. We encourage citizens to utilize this system when appropriate. Crimes of theft or vandalism with losses totaling less than \$5000 fair market value, and citizen's tips about criminal activity or unsafe circumstances in the region are examples of appropriate uses of this reporting format. Crimes with known suspects, burglaries, and vehicle thefts are examples of crimes that can not be reported using this system. <https://www.mycrimereport.us>


#### *Index*

- Index Case Reports completed for: 2 Animal complaints and 2 Assaults.
  - Animal complaints: One ticket was issued in October for barking dogs. One subject was contacted for an aggressive dog off leash. One additional complaint was documented for barking dogs.
  - We are working to clarify city/county boundaries for the Lower Town Wall parking lot. Most of the lot is privately owned and is in the county. The Crescent Trail, Town of Index property, encompasses the southeast corner of the lot and the entrance to the lot.
- Note: The numbers above do not always match the numbers shown in the charts on the following pages, in part because the statistics below are pulled from dispatch records which do not always accurately reflect the final type for the service call. A deputy may respond to a suspicious circumstance and later change the type to theft, for example.

The following charts and tables compare calls for service in the reporting months to the same months in the previous year and provide a monthly average (Typical Month) in each category. Data displayed is for all dispatch groups provided service by the Gold Bar Region (KK) and Index (RR) police agencies. All statistics may be viewed at Gold Bar City Hall.


## Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

### Reports and Arrests Made




## Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

### All Dispositions




## Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
