Notable Events of December 2014

Gold Bar

- Post office burglaries: Unknown person(s) broke into the Gold Bar Post Office between December 24 and December 26. The suspect(s) pried open several mailboxes and parcel boxes, stealing the contents from within. Since the initial burglary, the suspect(s) have broken into mailboxes two more times.
- Case report summary: 1 traffic hazard, 2 vandalism, 1 identity theft, 4 property theft, 4 burglary, 2 found property, 1 welfare check, 4 warrant arrests/attempts, 3 disturbance, 3 assault, 1 special offense, 1 court order violation. Final 2014 Police incident number for Gold Bar was 3324.
- Staffing changes: The annual shift rotation for our patrol division has been set. Two deputies have applied for the Gold Bar night shift position so far. The selection process will be completed in January.


- Significant incidents: Deputies responded to a report of an intoxicated man on the bridge threatening to jump. He was transported to a medical facility. Deputies received a complaint that unknown person(s) attempted to force open the water treatment plant gate with a vehicle.
- Complaint summary: 1 vandalism, 1 disturbance, 1 substance abuse, 1 911 hang-up. Final 2014 Police incident number for Index was 612. Unique to Index, an incident number is *usually* issued each time a deputy checks the town.

- Note: The numbers above do not always match the numbers shown in the charts on the following pages, in part because the statistics below are pulled from dispatch records which do not always accurately reflect the final type for the service call. A deputy may respond to a suspicious circumstance and later change the type to theft, for example.

The following charts and tables compare calls for service in the reporting months to the same months in the previous year and provide a monthly average (Typical Month) in each category. Data displayed is for all dispatch groups provided service by the Gold Bar Region (KK) and Index (RR) police agencies. All statistics may be viewed at Gold Bar City Hall.


Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

Reports and Arrests Made




Property Crime - Gold Bar Region

All Dispositions




Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
