

- Case report summary (summary of those incidents which generated an actual case report):  
5 Burglaries (we have a strong lead on 1 of these), 2 Assaults, 1 Disturbance, 1 Mental Health Contact, 1 Suspicious Circumstance, 1 Controlled Substance, 2 Theft (from vehicles), 3 Found Property, 1 Vehicle Theft, 1 Vehicle Impound, 2 Warrant Arrests, 1 Follow-up leading to solving 3 vehicle thefts, 1 trafficking stolen property case, and other stolen property recoveries.
- We have had a string of residential burglaries where entry was gained through a window by defeating the window lock without damaging the window. We have had a few of these since late spring and are working leads to solve them. Residents should employ additional measures to secure windows, such as dowels and or pins, to prevent the windows from being opened.

- Case number 5 for this year was issued for a theft where unknown suspects entered a vehicle and stole contents during a wedding.


- Note: The numbers above do not always match the numbers shown in the charts on the following pages, in part because the statistics below are pulled from dispatch records which do not always accurately reflect the final type for the service call. A deputy may respond to a suspicious circumstance and later change the type to theft, for example.




## Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
