### *Notable Events of October 2015*

- Homicide in County: A middle-aged male from the Gold Bar area was found deceased near Sultan due to an apparent homicide. An adult male is in custody and the investigation is ongoing.
- Except for Wa State Patrol, all police and fire agencies in Snohomish County switched over to the new dispatch and reporting system on October 27<sup>th</sup>. Unlike the experience of King County's east side agencies on "go-live", the system remains stable for Snohomish County. This system is completely new and we are working out the bugs while learning to use it at the same time. Deputies will be spending additional time to complete reports until they become more familiar with the system and the occasional bugs we discover along the way are resolved.
- A hunt for an Index area man wanted for first degree assault and robbery near Monroe ended when he was arrested while shoplifting in Bellevue. The adult male victim sustained life threatening and debilitating injuries.

### *Gold Bar*

- Case reports: 2 Assault, 2 Disturbance, 1 Child Abuse, 1 Suspicious Person, 2 Warrant Arrest, 3 Theft, 1 Assist other Police, 1 Death Investigation.

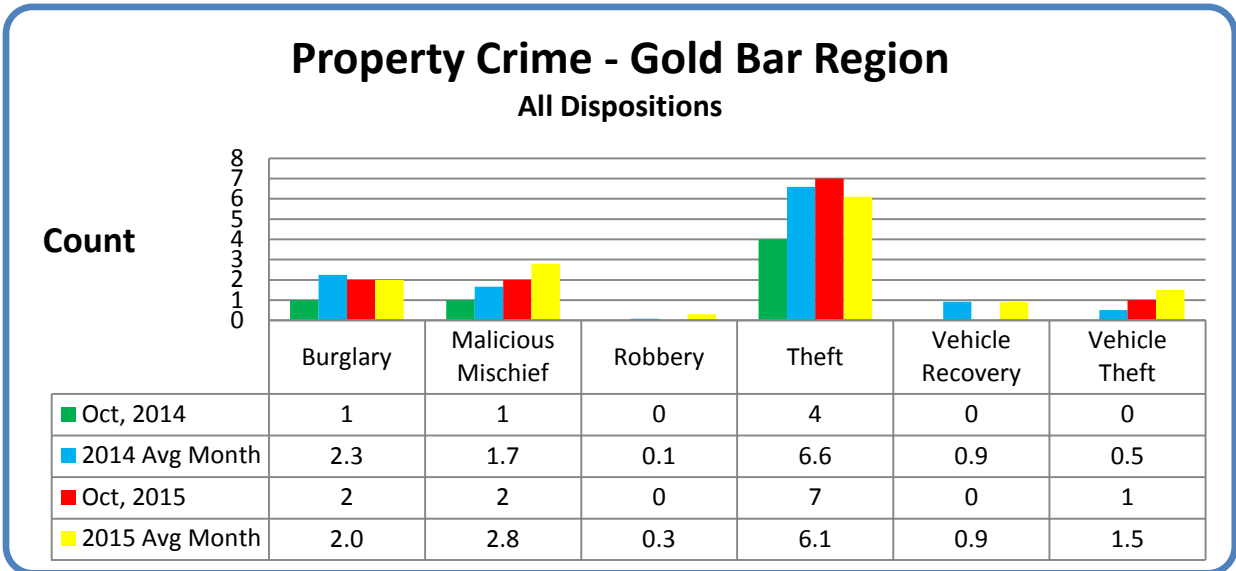
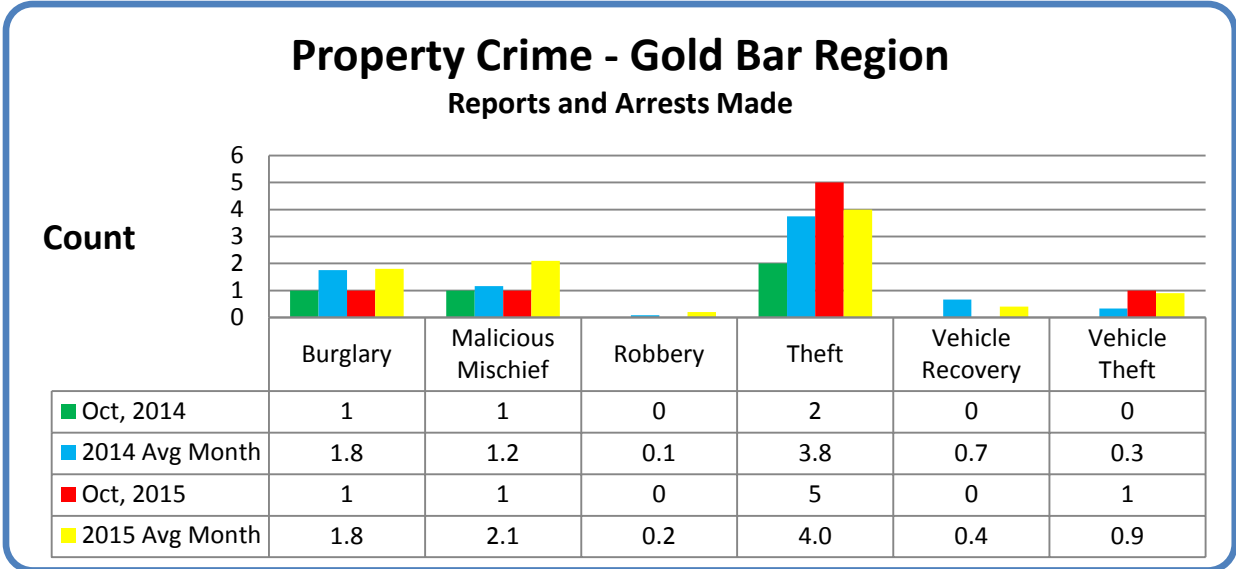
### *Index*

- No case reports for crime in Index prior to October 27<sup>th</sup>.

A deputy may respond to a suspicious circumstance and later change the type to theft, for example.

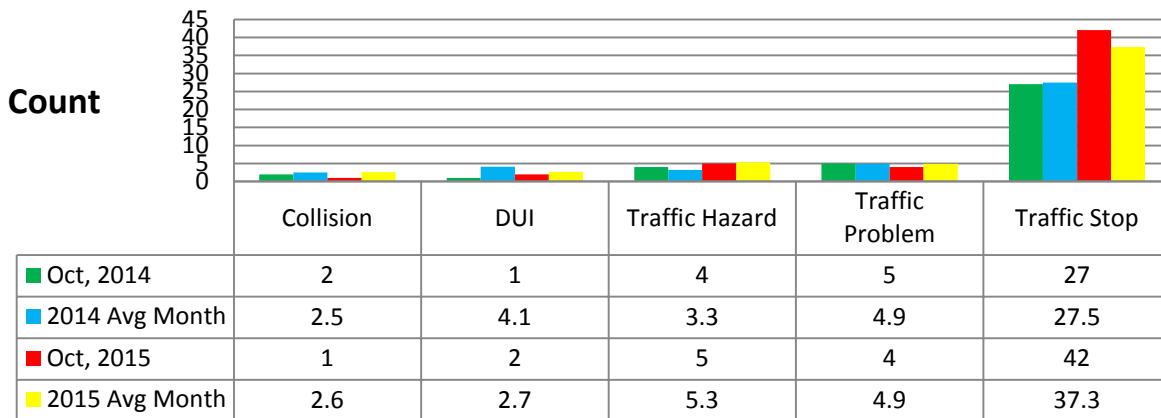

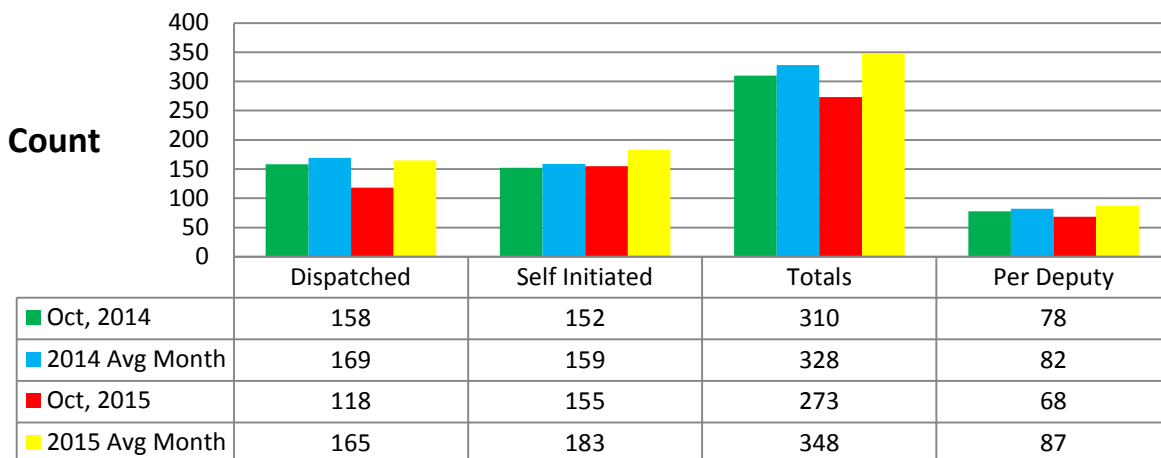


## Traffic Calls - Gold Bar Region
