
Notable Events of March 2016


- Gold Bar: A male in his 20's who had been in custody, charged with two counts of Residential Burglary, was released on his own recognizance, pending further proceedings, just days prior to the last council meeting. My comment that he was in custody was in error. He has since been arrested and booked into jail for outstanding warrants resulting from his failure to appear in court as ordered, and for suspicion of a new felony crime that occurred during the short time he was out of jail.
- Gold Bar: We've received reports of excessive speed and unsafe passing on US 2 in Gold Bar and have
 responded with traffic enforcement details. The great majority of drivers travelling through town are doing so
 within reasonably safe parameters. Two tickets were issued relating to unlawfully passing, excessive speed, and
 driving without liability insurance. Several drivers received warnings for speeding.
- Gold Bar: A 16 year old male with an adult passenger borrowed his mother's partially disabled car without her knowledge, drove it in town at high speed, and caused damage to several vehicles and both private and public property. The prosecutor has been asked to review the case for charges of Hit and Run, and Reckless Driving. The driver was examined by aid personnel. No other persons were injured.
- Gold Bar: Deputies responded to a report of domestic violence and arrested a male for threats to kill and domestic violence assault. The victim has since moved out of state.
- Deputy Jason Sandt and his family, having just recently moved here from Florida, decided against remaining in the Pacific Northwest and he is again employed as a police officer near the east coast. Deputy Stuart Gort, a five year veteran transfer from the Washington State Patrol, has taken his position in the Gold Bar Region on night shift.
- Index: No significant incidents to report for Index.


