
## **Notable Events of April 2016**


- A 25 year old man from unincorporated Snohomish County, near Gold Bar, was shot by an 80 year old homeowner when he intruded into her residence, northwest of Sultan, and attacked her 75 year old husband, striking him in the head with a blunt weapon and stabbing him. The intruder died at the scene. The 75 year old man was flown to a Seattle hospital and is recovering.
- Warm weather is here but the rivers are still running very cold. Use caution near moving water, wear life vests, and remember that cold water can overwhelm and incapacitate a competent swimmer in seconds.

The following tables and charts compare incident types of service as reported for the Gold Bar Regional contract. This contract has an Originating Agency Identifier (ORI) of WA0311000.


