#### Gold Bar


- Brett Card was arrested after we received a Crime Stoppers tip.

- ID theft: Deputies investigating a theft of a check from mail identified and arrested a suspect who cashed the check.

  Referral, 1 Possession Stolen Property, 1 Suspicious Circumstance, 4 Warrant Arrests.




