

**CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON
ORDINANCE #712**

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE GOLD BAR MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Gold Bar Municipal Code Title 2.08.030 relating to the office of city clerk was amended to change the requirement of an hourly position; and

WHEREAS, the office of city clerk and city treasurer are currently combined but have been separated in the past and may be separated again; and

WHEREAS, the office of city treasurer was not amended relating to hourly vs. salaried positions;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOLD BAR ORDAINS that Title 2 be amended as follows.

- Section I, Title 2.08.040**
- Section II, Severability**
- Section III, Effective Date**

Section I, Title 2.08.040

The office of city treasurer shall be filled through a hiring process and appointment by the mayor, with confirmation by the council. This office shall be hourly, salaried, or contractual, at the decision of the mayor. The position may be terminated without cause by the mayor at any time.

Section II, Severability

This ordinance is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section III, Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect from, and after, its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
