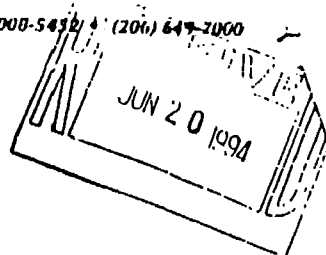

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**REPORT**

**BACKGROUND:**

This application was received on December 8, 1992 requesting 750 gpm (gallons per minute) from a well for municipal supply.

Notice was published in the Monroe Monitor-Valley News on September 15 and 22, 1993. No protests were submitted regarding the appropriation request.

**INVESTIGATION:**

Evaluation of this application consists of review of office records, visit to the site on March 4, 1994, and conversations with representatives for the City of Gold Bar.

The City of Gold Bar is in the Skykomish River Valley thirty miles east of Everett in Snohomish County. The well site for well #4 is one half mile from the Skykomish River and one-quarter mile from May Creek being within SW¼ SW¼ of Section 5, T. 27 N., R. 9 E., W.M. of Snohomish County.

The city holds paper rights for the following sources and quantities.

Gold Bar currently obtains all their water from the three wells covered by the two referenced ground water certificates. There is an intertie with Snohomish County PUD but only for emergency use. The city has 350,000 gallons of storage with an additional 250,000 gallon storage underway.

Gold Bar intends to use the deep well to replace wells 1,2, and 3 which are developed next to May Creek in a shallow water table aquifer. With a maximum pumping capacity of the three wells the city is not able to meet peak day demand requirements of the Health Department; the new well should meet the deficiency needed to satisfy Health's criteria. Once well #4 is on line, wells 1,2, and 3 will be used as emergency standby source of water.

Well #4 development details were obtained from the engineering report prepared by Geo Engineers. The well was drilled in November 1993 to a depth of 720 feet. After well completion shut in pressure of the well was 25 psi which corresponds to a pressure head of approximately 60 feet above land surface. A stepped rate pump test was conducted on February 25, 1994 which determined that the well could be pumped at a constant rate of 410 gpm. On February 28, 1994, the 24 hour constant rate pump test was conducted which resulted in a total drawdown of 343 feet (283 feet below the ground plus 60 feet of artesian pressure). Full recovery to pre test conditions of 25 psi shut in pressure occurred in 4.2 minutes after pumping stopped. The consultants recommended and the applicant agrees that the well be designed to pump at a maximum rate of 410 gpm. Based on the pump test results, this application will be considered for a maximum of 410 gpm rather than the applied quantity of 750 gpm.

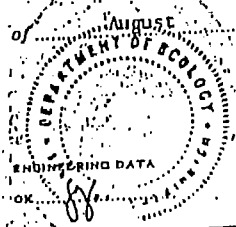
All water wells constructed within the state shall meet the minimum standards for construction and maintenance as provided under RCW 18.104 (Washington Water Well Construction Act of 1971) and Chapter 173-160 WAC (Minimum Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells).

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
