A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING SUPPORT FOR THE 2017 EGG HUNT

WHEREAS, volunteers within the City of Gold Bar annually host an egg hunt funded solely from donations; and

WHEREAS donations for 2017 are insufficient to cover expenses; and

WHEREAS the annual egg hunt benefits the community of Gold Bar by providing a safe location for local families with young children to gather; and

WHEREAS the annual egg hunt contributes to building a sense of community within Gold Bar and encourages residents to spend time out of doors and enjoying exercise; and

WHEREAS community events such as the annual egg hunt provide the same tangible community benefits to the City as providing parks for residents; and

WHEREAS providing supplies for the annual egg hunt does not constitute a gifting of public funds because this is for a valid public purpose that builds community relationships and encourages people to come to Gold Bar, contributing to tourism;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the City will sponsor the 2017 community egg hunt as follows:

The City of Gold Bar will make a one-time purchase of supplies to be used for the annual egg hunt not to exceed three hundred (\$300) dollars. City staff will purchase supplies directly.
