CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 17-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING COASTAL COMMUNITY BANK SIGNATORY AUTHORITIES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Office Manager are signatories on Coastal Community Bank accounts; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution is required to authorize the Mayor and Office Manager as signatories; and

WHEREAS, previous resolutions authorized signatories based on the name of Mayors; and

WHEREAS, the position changes through elections cycles; and

WHEREAS, the offices of Mayor and Office Manager are required to be a signatories on bank accounts regardless of the specific person filling such position;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the signatory responsibilities for City bank accounts be as follows.

- I. Signatory Responsibilities, Office of Mayor
- II. Resolution Repeal
- II. Severability
- III. Effective Date

I. Signatory Responsibilities, Office of Mayor

The position of Mayor for the City of Gold Bar shall be responsible for signing on bank accounts. This responsibility shall continue with the office of Mayor. Each new Mayor will be required to obtain signatory authority through Coastal Community Bank after a motion by the Council authorizing such signatory authority to the specific person filling the position of Mayor for the City of Gold Bar.

The position of Office Manager for the City of Gold Bar shall be responsible for signing on bank accounts. This responsibility shall continue with the position of Office Manager. Each new Office Manager will be required to obtain signatory authority through Coastal Community Bank after a motion by the Council authorizing such signatory authority to the specific person filling the position of Office Manager for the City of Gold Bar.

II. Resolution Repeal

This Resolution repeals all prior resolutions setting specific names to signatory authority for Coastal Community Bank and the positions of Mayor and Office Manager.

III. Severability

This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

IV. Effective Date

This resolution shall take effect from the date of its adoption.
