## CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON ORDINANCE #711

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE #709, SAID ORDINANCE BEING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31<sup>ST</sup> 2018.

WHEREAS, the City of Gold Bar was unable to secure USDA funding for the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main and Sidewalk project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gold Bar was unable to secure a Coastal Community Bank commercial loan for the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main and Sidewalk project; and

WHEREAS, after research the City will save interest and legal fees by self-funding the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main and Sidewalk project; and

WHEREAS, self-funding the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main and Sidewalk project means that the project will no longer be funded through grants or loans; and

WHEREAS, self-funding will result in the street overlay portion of the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main and Sidewalk Project being funded through the Capital Fund (301); and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Gold Bar authorized self-funding of the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main and Sidewalk project at their meeting of January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the change in funding means the 2018 budget must be adjusted to correct funding sources;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOLD BAR ORDAINS that the 2018 budget is amended as follows:

Section I, Grants Fund (302)
Section II, Water Capital Fund (403)
Section III, Capital Fund (301)
Section IV, Severability
Section V, Effective Date

## Section I, Grants Fund (302)

The Grants Fund shall be amended to decrease revenue and expenditures in the amount of \$400,000.

# Section II, Water Capital Fund (403)

The Water Capital Fund shall be amended in increase expenditures in the amount of \$400,000.

## Section III, Capital Fund (301)

The Capital Fund shall be amended to increase expenditures in the amount of \$24,000.

### Section IV, Severability

This ordinance is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

#### Section V, Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect from, and after, its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
