**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON ADOPTING
PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2019**

Whereas, the Council of the City of Gold Bar has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2019; and

Whereas, the district's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$220,720.00; and


Whereas, the population of this district is less than 10,000;

Now therefore, be it resolved by the governing body of the taxing district that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2019 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$9,198.24 which is a percentage increase of 4.16738% from the previous year which includes a 1% increase plus banked capacity of \$6,991.04. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred, and refunds made.
