RESOLUTION NO. 19-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE 2019
COMMUNITY EGG HUNT**

WHEREAS, the Red Hat Society traditionally hosts an egg hunt for the community, funded from donations; and

WHEREAS, donations for 2019 are insufficient to cover expenses; and

WHEREAS, the annual egg hunt builds a sense of community and directly benefits the community of Gold Bar by providing a safe location for local families with young children to gather; and

WHEREAS, community events such as the annual egg hunt provide the same tangible community benefits to the City as providing parks for residents; and

WHEREAS, providing supplies for the annual egg hunt does not constitute a gifting of public funds because the funds are for a valid public purpose that builds community relationships and encourages people to come to Gold Bar, contributing to tourism;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar as follows.

Section II Severability
Section III Effective Date

Section I, 2019 Annual Egg Hunt

The City of Gold Bar will provide a one-time purchase of supplies to be used for supporting the Red Hat Society in their annual egg hunt, in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100). City staff shall purchase those supplies directly.

Section II, Severability

This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section III, Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect from, and after, its passage and approval, as provided by law.
