Proclamation

WHEREAS, pediatric cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in children; and

WHEREAS, one in 285 children in the United States will be diagnosed by their twentieth birthday; and

WHEREAS, eighty percent of childhood cancer cases are diagnosed only after the disease has metastasized and spread to other areas of the body; and

WHEREAS, two-thirds of childhood cancer patients will have long-lasting chronic conditions as a result of the treatments they go through; and

WHEREAS, there has been a twenty-four percent increase in pediatric cancer cases over the last forty years; equal to forty-three children per day diagnosed with cancer in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the National Cancer Institute recognized the unique research needs of childhood cancer and increased funding to conduct this research; and

WHEREAS, in the last twenty years, only four new drugs have been developed specifically to treat children with cancer; and

WHEREAS, researchers and healthcare professionals work diligently to dedicate their expertise to treat and cure children with cancer; and

WHEREAS, too many children are affected by this deadly disease and more must be done to raise awareness and find a cure;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Gold Bar does hereby proclaim September, 2019 to be Childhood Cancer Awareness Month and encourages residents to join in this special observance.
