
### Notable Events of January 2019


- Case summary: 3 Suspicious Circumstance (1 is a possible ID theft and 1 is a possible Vehicle Theft or Fraud); 2 Traffic Crime referrals to the prosecutor; 2 Warrant Arrests; 1 Shoplift; 1 Drug Possession; 1 Death Investigation; 2 Burglaries (1 abandoned structure, and 1 storage building at a business closed for construction)
- A Gold Bar man is in custody for multiple offenses related to theft, vehicle prowl and vehicle theft. There are additional persons of interest in these cases across multiple jurisdictions (Gold Bar, Sultan, Monroe, Snohomish County, Everett) and the investigations continue.
- Gold Bar Region deputies are looking into allegations that *some* area businesses are operating without business licenses, a crime in the State of WA.



# Gold Bar

- Gold Bar Case Summary: 2 Assault, 1 Collision, 1 Robbery 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, 2 Burglary, 1 Malicious Mischief, 1 Mental Health, 1 Suspicious Circumstance, 1 Domestic Disturbance, 1 Traffic Offense, 1 Attempt to Elude Police Vehicle, 1 Warrant Arrest, 1 Vehicle Theft, 1 Vehicle Recovery.
- Emphasis Patrol: Deputies conducted a planned emphasis in Gold Bar to address crime, drugs and traffic safety in and around Gold Bar. The drug task force assisted, as well as SCSO K-9. We made several traffic stops for infractions such as running stop signs. We identified persons of interest during the planning and, based on this, actually stopped one Gold Bar man the day before the emphasis, netting significant quantity of drugs and cash. We've asked the prosecutor to charge him with possession with intent to deliver (drug dealing). During the emphasis we stopped one man for criminal traffic and applied a drug dog sniff to the outside of the car. The dog indicated on the car and it was seized for a search warrant for drugs, netting suspected Heroin. A man who has previously fled from police on an ATV fled from us during the emphasis. Not wishing to engage in a pursuit which can pose significant risk to the community, we asked the task force undercover units to follow and observe until he was off the vehicle, then apprehended him within seconds using the K-9 unit.



### Notable Events of June 2019

- Gold Bar reports: 1 Trespass, 1 Mental Health, 2 Disturbance, 1 Vehicle Impound, 1 Death Investigation, 1 DUI with Pursuit, 1 Welfare Check, 1 Assault, 3 Warrant Arrest, 1 Hit and Run Collision, 1 Theft, 2 Burglary, 1 Suspicious Circumstance, 1 Missing Person later located
- On 06-11 deputies responded to a report of a man down, CPR in progress, at 9<sup>th</sup> and Croft. A man from the South Fork died at the scene after witnesses saw him collapse in his vehicle and rendered CPR. The cause of death is under investigation by the Medical Examiner's Office.
- School District Personnel reported on 06-26 that a man broke into a portable classroom the night before and
  attempted to steal a laptop computer. The alarm was tripped at the school on 06-25 and a custodian was
  dispatched to check the building. When he arrived he confronted a man exiting the building with one of the
  school's laptop computers. He retrieved the computer and the suspect left on foot. Police were not notified
  until staff discovered the next day that the incident was captured on video. A Gold Bar man was identified and
  arrested for Burglary.
- On 06-30 a neighbor saw a man burglarizing a garage on 19<sup>th</sup> Street and alerted the homeowner. The incident was captured on video and deputies immediately recognized the man as a frequent contact. After reporting the incident, the home owner and witness spotted the same man and followed him, calling 911. The man, seeing he was being followed, ducked into a local diner and fled out the back. An Everett K-9 attempted to track the suspect but while chasing through a back yard on 9<sup>th</sup> St, the dog fell into an open and overflowing septic tank, ending the track. Deputies, responding to tips from neighbors, arrested the man the next day near his home on 9<sup>th</sup> Street.









  surrendered when SWAT announced they had a search warrant and would be making entry.







- Safety Tip: Check your vehicle tires for excessive tread wear. Be sure your tires are adequate for winter driving conditions. If your tires have wear indicators (wear bars), State Law may require that they be replaced when worn to the indicator bars even when remaining tread depth exceeds 2/32 of an inch.





### Notable Events of December 2019


- Gold Bar Case Reports: 1 Civil Dispute, 3 Burglary, 1 Theft with ID Theft added, 4 Fraud/Forgery/ID Theft, 1 Traffic Crime, 1 Domestic Violence Assault, 1 Domestic Disturbance, 1 Warrant Arrest.
- On December 10<sup>th</sup>, School Resource Deputy Hess investigated a burglary of a mobile classroom at the Elementary School. Within 2 hours, both suspects were identified. The male and female suspects were booked into Snohomish County Jail on December 11<sup>th</sup> and December 12<sup>th</sup> respectively. Two of the stolen iPads were recovered during the arrest of the male.
- On December 18<sup>th</sup>, Chief Casey investigated a vehicle prowl at the Elementary School where two suspects arrived in a Kia sedan and stole a purse from a vehicle; then when shopping with the victim's bank card at Fred Meyer in Monroe. Thanks to assistance from Fred Meyer loss prevention and Seattle PD, a known gang member from south King County his known girlfriend have been identified as persons of interest. This investigation is ongoing.
- Time for Transfers: At the shift bid this year, the four Deputies covering Gold Bar will not be transferring. Deputy Doersch is on extended leave and we will have a temporarily assigned deputy to cover until he returns. Chief Casey WILL be transferring. I have been asked by Sheriff Fortney to take over our Office of Professional Accountability, often known as Internal Affairs. Lieutenant Martin and Captain Jeske will be conducting a test to identify my replacement. Serving as your Chief of Police has been, without a doubt, the most rewarding experience of my 28 years in law enforcement. I will absolutely miss you all!




