Notable Events of February 2021

- On Thursday Feb 4th the Washington State Supreme Court issued a ruling in the case of State v. Blake. The ruling declared that RCW 69.50.4013 Washington's simple possession of controlled substance statute violates the due process clause of the state and federal constitution and is now void. We believe this ruling takes effect immediately.

Effective immediately, Washington law enforcement officers are no longer authorized to conduct a criminal investigation, effect an arrest, seek a search warrant, or take any other law enforcement action for simple possession of a controlled substance pursuant to RCW 69.50.4013(1). As of right now this would also include seizure of the substance.

- I am asking the Mayor and the Gold Bar City Council to consider adopting the Snohomish County Ordinance of Drug Paraphernalia. I have attached the county ordinance. The county ordinance provides a definition, a criminal charge along with penalties and other information. The county ordinance cannot be used in the City of Gold Bar as it is a county code. If the City of Gold Bar adopts it then deputies can then effect arrests and or seize narcotics if they can articulate the ordinance violation. I have attached the county ordinance for your review.
- Ordinance violation on Timber lane. The homeowner was issued the ordinance warning of the violation. 2 warrant arrests were recently made at this same location.
- A Snohomish County Sheriff's oral board testing will be completed on March 4th to establish an eligibility list to fill any vacancy that occur in the Gold Bar Police Department.
- I have submitted a letter to the Mayor and City Council requesting an item to be purchased for Gold Bar PD patrol vehicles.
- I have attached the new crime data report. It is broken out by the area beats of Gold Bar as well as the City of Gold Bar ORI. If the captions are blank that would indicate there was no crime reported for that caption. You will see the data is color coded making it easier for you to review and understand. Information that should be noted is:
 1. Traffic enforcement is up both in the area of and in the City of Gold Bar
 2. The map has the location of the incident with a color code along with a pin wheel defining the incident.
 3. Crime remains flat with no increases at this time.

10.48.010
Definitions.



The term "drug paraphernalia" means all equipment, products, and materials of any kind whose primary design function is for use in planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packaging, repackaging, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling or otherwise introducing into the human body unlawful drugs, including but not limited to controlled substances as defined by chapter 69.50 RCW. Such term includes but is not limited to:

- (1) Kits used, intended for use, or designed for use in the planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, or harvesting of any species of plant which is a controlled substance or from which a controlled substance or unlawful drug can be derived;
- (2) Kits used, intended for use, or designed for use in the manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, or preparing of unlawful drugs;
- (3) Isomerization devices used, intended for use, or designed for use in increasing the potency of any species of plant which is an unlawful drug;
- (4) Testing equipment used, intended for use, or designed for use in identifying, or in analyzing the strength, effectiveness, or purity of unlawful drugs;
- (5) Scales and balances used, intended for use, or designed for use in weighing or measuring unlawful drugs;
- (6) Diluents and adulterants, such as quinine hydrochloride, mannitol, mannite, dextrose and lactose, used, intended for use, or designed for use in cutting unlawful drugs;
- (7) Separation gins and sifters used, intended for use, or designed for use in removing twigs and seeds from, or in otherwise cleaning or refining marijuana;
- (8) Blenders, bowls, containers, spoons, and mixing devices used, intended for use, or designed for use in compounding unlawful drugs;
- (9) Capsules, balloons, envelopes, and other containers used, intended for use, or designed for use in packaging small quantities of unlawful drugs;
- (10) Containers and other objects used, intended for use, or designed for use in storing or concealing unlawful drugs;
- (11) Objects used, intended for use, or designed for use in ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing marijuana, cocaine, hashish, or hashish oil into the human body, such as:
 - (a) Metal, wooden, acrylic, glass, stone, plastic, or ceramic pipes, with or without screens, permanent screens, hashish heads, or punctured metal bowls;

It is unlawful for any person to deliver, possess with intent to deliver, or manufacture with intent to deliver, any item of drug paraphernalia, knowing, or under circumstances where one reasonably should know, that it will be used to plant, propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, conceal, inject, ingest, inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance in violation of this code. Any person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be imprisoned for not more than 90 days, fined not more than \$500.00, or both. (Amended by Ord. 80-111, Dec. 15, 1980).

Advertisement of drug paraphernalia.



It is unlawful for any person to place in any newspaper, magazine, handbill, or other publication any advertisement, or to display on any poster, readerboard or billboard or sign of any sort, knowing, or under circumstances where one reasonably should know, that the purpose of the advertisement or display, in whole or in part, is to promote the sale of any object designed or intended for use as drug paraphernalia. Any person who violates this section is guilty of a crime and upon conviction may be imprisoned for not more than 90 days, fined not more than \$500.00, or both. (Amended by Ord. 80-111, Dec. 15, 1980).

10.48.050

Nuisance.



The distribution or possession for the purpose of sale, exhibition or display, in any place, public or private, of any devices, contrivances, instruments, or paraphernalia, including all items defined as drug paraphernalia in SCC [10.48.010](#), which are primarily designed for or intended to be used for the smoking, ingestion, or consumption of marijuana, hashish, PCP, or any controlled substance, other than prescription drugs and devices to ingest or inject prescription drugs, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and may be abated by Snohomish county. This remedy shall be in addition to any other remedy provided by law, including the penalty provisions applicable for violation of the terms and provisions of this chapter. (Amended by Ord. 80-111, Dec. 15, 1980).

10.48.060

Seizure and forfeiture.



- (1) The following are subject to seizure and forfeiture:
 - (a) All drug paraphernalia.
- (2) Upon showing of probable cause that any property is subject to seizure or forfeiture, any court of competent jurisdiction may issue a warrant for the seizure thereof. Any peace officer having probable cause to believe that property is subject to seizure and forfeiture may seize the same provided proceedings for forfeiture shall be commenced within a reasonable time and in no case more than five days after the initial seizure.
- (3) Property seized in accord with the section or subject to forfeiture shall be forfeited by civil proceedings commenced in the same manner as other civil actions of a like nature. Property abandoned or lost or for whom the owner cannot be determined shall be disposed of as is other lost property.
- (4) The property forfeited shall be the sole property of Snohomish county. (Amended by Ord. 80-111, Dec. 15, 1980).

Severability.



If any provision or section of this chapter shall be held to be void or unconstitutional, all other parts, provisions, and sections of this chapter not expressly so held to be void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect. (Amended by Ord. 80-111, Dec. 15, 1980).

Effective date.



This chapter shall be effective on January 1, 1981. (Amended by Ord. 80-111, Dec. 15, 1980).

Re: Purchasing of Tonneau Bed Covers for Gold Bar patrol vehicles

Dear Mayor Clem:

The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office patrol vehicles assigned to the Gold Bar contract are Ford F-150 pickup trucks. This type of vehicle is assigned as it allows for 4x4 control as well as ground clearance. The amount of equipment that Deputies are assigned is significant. Since Deputies are assigned pick up trucks there is no trunk space which causes the rear seats to be used for storage and a small portion to be used for transport of people.

I am currently looking to personalize the pickup trucks assigned to the Gold Bar contract. This would include a personalized Gold Bar decal installed on the rear tailgate. The cost involved for this is one that I can afford in my current supply budget. These decals would also be installed on the new pick up trucks that are assigned to the Gold Bar contract.

At this time, I am respectfully requesting that the City of Gold Bar consider purchasing tonneau bed covers for the Sheriff's Office pickup trucks that are assigned to the City of Gold Bar. These tonneau covers would be a hard-top model which is waterproof and will have a locking mechanism. If we can obtain these bed covers the equipment currently in the back seats can be moved to the truck bed in an organized system. The locking mechanism of the bed cover as well as the locking tailgate will secure the items.

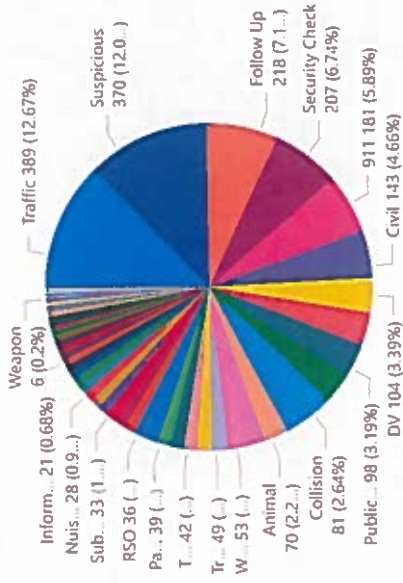

Count of IncidentNumber by IncidentType



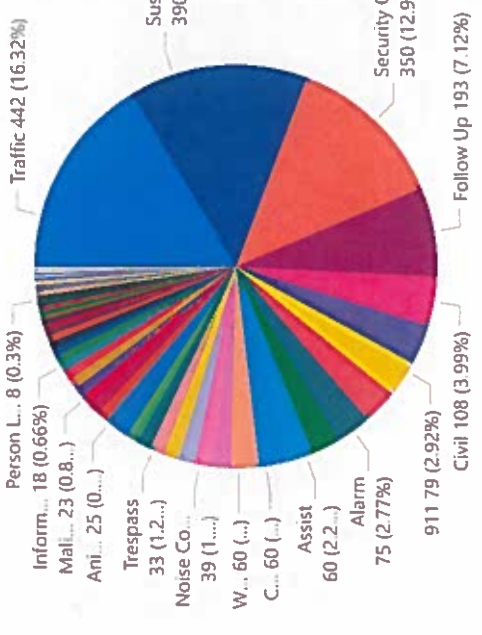
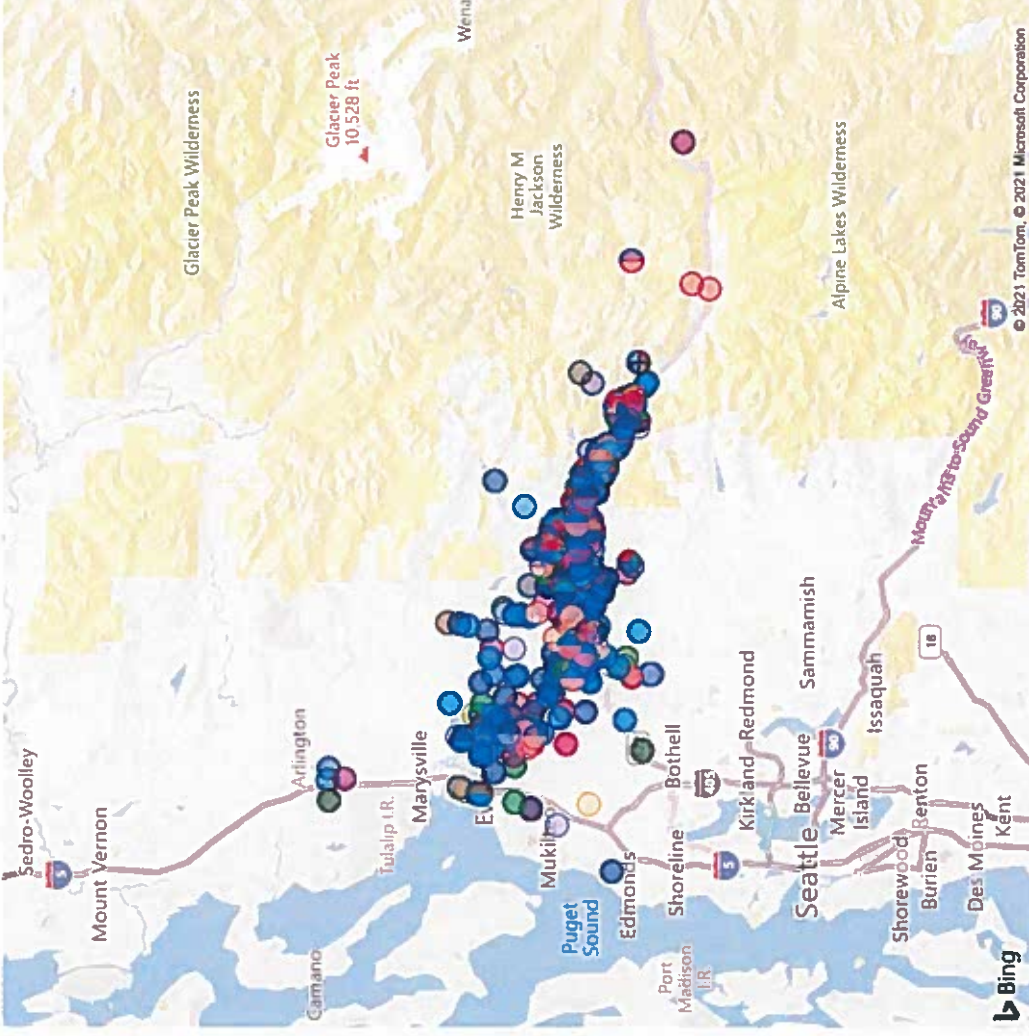

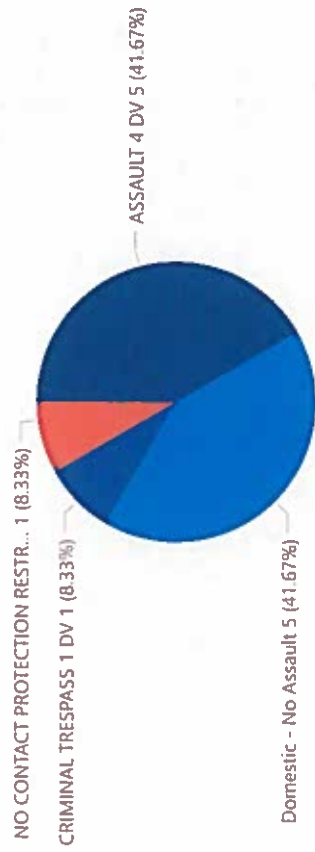

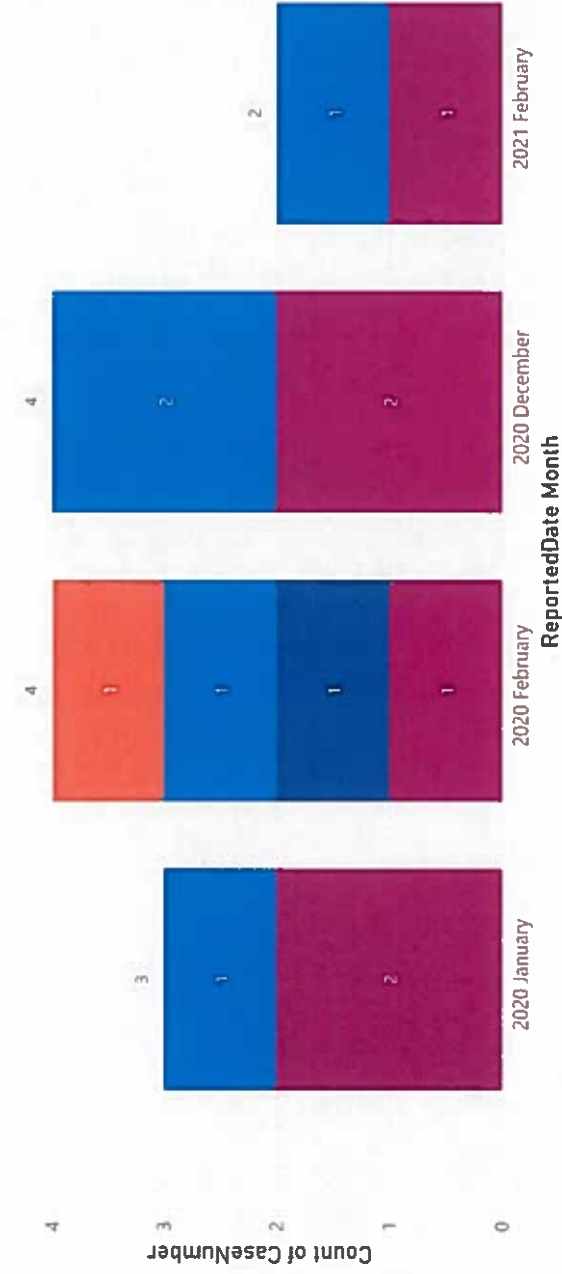
Count of CaseNumber by Statute Descript



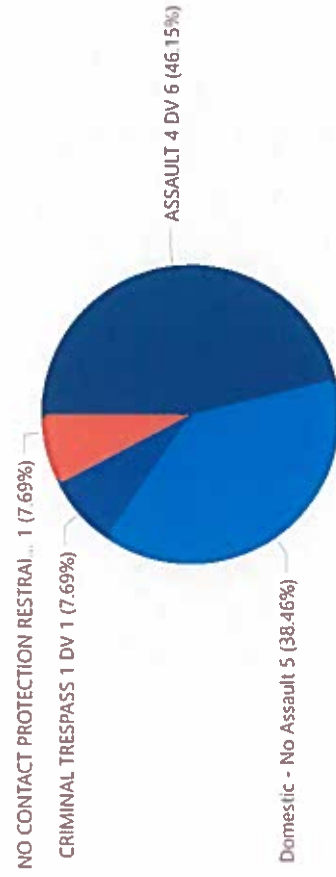
