RESOLUTION NO. 21-06**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON ADOPTING A SIX-YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND DIRECTING THE SAME TO BE FILED WITH THE STATE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapters 35.77 and 47.26 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW), the City has previously adopted a Comprehensive Street Program, including an arterial street construction program, and thereafter periodically modifies the said Comprehensive Street Program by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the work accomplished under said Program, determined current and future City street and arterial needs, and based upon these findings, has prepared a Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the ensuing six (6) calendar years; and

WHEREAS, the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (2021 – 2027) adopted herein is consistent with the City’s Capital Facilities Plan and Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on the said Six – Year Transportation Improvement Program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar as follows.

Section I, Program Adopted

The Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the City of Gold Bar, as revised and extended for the ensuing six (6) calendar years of 2021 – 2027, inclusive, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth, which Program sets forth the project location, type of improvements, and the estimated cost thereof, is hereby adopted and approved.

Section II, Filing of Program

Pursuant to RCW Chapter 35.77, the City Clerk is hereby authorized to file a copy of this Resolution forthwith, together with the Exhibit A attached hereto, with the Secretary of Transportation and with the Transportation Improvement Board for the State of Washington.

Section III, Severability

This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section IV, Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect from, and after, its passage and approval, as provided by law.
