

**CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON
RESOLUTION NO. 21-06**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, public records requests that cost less than one dollar (\$1.00) can potentially delay responses while the City waits for such low payments; and

WHEREAS, unaltered dogs cost residents more to license than altered dogs, but that difference in cost is not reflected in senior citizen discounts; and

WHEREAS, water system fees related to service connections do not reflect costs to the City;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the Fee Schedule be amended as follows.

Section I, Title VIII, Administrative Fees

D. Document and public records costs and fees.

11. The City shall waive Public Records Request fees under one dollar (\$1.00) if the charge of such fee could result in a delay in providing responsive records.

12. Any Public Records Request fee that includes seventy-five cents (\$.75) or less shall be rounded down to the nearest dollar.

Section II, Title VI. Animal License and Control Fees
