WHEREAS, City of Gold Bar Councilmembers may occasionally be asked by the Mayor or Council to represent the City at specific meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Council Policies and Procedures manual does not address these meetings;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar, that the Council Rules of Procedures shall be amended as follows.

Section I, Section AA, Council Procedures Specific to the City of Gold Bar

AA. Council Procedures Specific to the City of Gold Bar

- 4. Elected and/or appointed officials are expected to attend Council meetings, special meetings, public hearings, and any other official gathering of the Council to conduct City business. Elected and/or appointed officials may obtain an excused absence from the Council for unavoidable situations.
 - a. If a Councilmember is directed by the Mayor to attend a meeting outside of the normal business meetings noted above, that Councilmember shall be paid a stipend of twenty-five dollars (\$25) plus mileage. Mileage must be documented in writing and submitted to the Clerk/Treasurer no later than two weeks after the meeting.

Section II, Severability

This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section III, Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect from, and after, its passage and approval, as provided by law.
