

**CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON
ORDINANCE #753**

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 10, VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC**

WHEREAS, Gold Bar Municipal Code Title 10.12.060 addresses restricted parking; and

WHEREAS, new development within City limits results in the need to amend restricted parking regulation; and

WHEREAS, Wallace Falls State Park creates parking issues and can impact parking in residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the benefits of the State Park; and

WHEREAS, the City also recognizes the need to balance the parking needs of visitors with the parking needs of residents;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOLD BAR ORDAINS as follows:

Section I, Title 10.12.060 – Restricted Parking

10.12.060 - Restricted parking.

H. Parking Permits. No vehicle shall park on residential streets that are designated ‘Permit Parking Only’ without a City-issued decal clearly visible on the vehicle.

1. On-street parking permits for residents shall be obtained by applying to the City of Gold Bar and providing proof of residence. There is no associated fee.

a. Residents shall be limited to no more than four (4) parking decals. Residents may apply to the City’s Public Works Director and/or Office Manager, for a variance if their home requires parking spaces for more than four (4) vehicles.

b. There shall be no fee for residents seeking parking permits for their places of residence.

c. Residents on designated ‘Permit Parking Only’ streets shall display parking decals on their vehicles in an easily visible and identifiable location. Those residents in designated areas that do not display decals shall receive a warning letter that will include a timeline by which they must apply for, and receive, a parking permit or risk having their vehicle towed.

2. Vehicles parked in designated ‘Permit Parking Only’ streets without a Parking decal shall have their vehicles ticketed and/or towed at the owner’s expense.

Section VI, Severability

This ordinance is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section VII, Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect from, and after, its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
