**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON REGARDING SECURITY
MONITORING**

WHEREAS, recent acts of vandalism now require security monitoring; and

WHEREAS, the City does not currently have a security monitoring policy; and

WHEREAS, the creation of such a policy creates clear and written guidelines;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the City's security monitoring policy shall be as follows.

Section I Security Monitoring Policy
Section II Severability
Section III Effective Date

Section I, Security Monitoring Policy

A. City staff shall utilize security monitoring devices that best match the City's needs and technical requirements, and law enforcement best practice recommendations, for security purposes only.

B. Recorded material will be reviewed regularly by designated City staff and referred to law enforcement personnel for matters of security issues.

C. Recorded material will be retained following the Washington Secretary of State record retention requirements.

Section II, Severability

This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section III, Effective Date


This Resolution shall take effect from, and after, its passage and approval, as provided by law.
