A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Gold Bar has met and reviewed the budget for 2023; and

WHEREAS, as part of budget review, certain rates must be increased in order to meet projected costs; and

WHEREAS, proposed rate increases are calculated as the minimum amount needed in order to be fiscally sound;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the Fee Schedule be amended as follows.

B. Impact Fees

 - b. Residential: \$1,200 per dwelling unit
2. Park impact fees: ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,937 per dwelling unit

- 3. Assessment rate for qualifying low-income senior citizens, all locations
~~\$15.41~~ \$16.35 per month

Section IV, Stormwater Rates

X. Stormwater Rates

- 1. Stormwater rates shall be \$12.05 per household, commercial business, and/or unit.
- 2. Stormwater rates for qualifying low-income senior citizens shall be \$9.09.

Section V, Severability

This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section VI, Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect from, and after, its passage and approval, as provided by law.
