A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON FOR THE SURPLUSING AND SALE  
OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City Council of Gold Bar has a policy in place, created by Resolution No. 20-01, that allows the surplus and sale of City property as detailed in the Resolution's related *Purchase, Procurement, and Sale Policy*; and

WHEREAS, the City may occasionally surplus or sell aged, or no longer needed, equipment and/or supplies; and

WHEREAS, the *Purchase, Procurement, and Sale Policy*, section XVIII states 'upon recommendations of the Mayor or supervisor, property with an estimated value under \$15,000 may be declared surplus by the Mayor or supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the properties listed in this resolution have estimated values under \$15,000 per item and have been declared so by the Mayor and the Public Works Director;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the following items shall be designated as surplus and are to be sold or disposed in a manner consistent with the *Purchase, Procurement, and Sale Policy*.

**Section I, Surplus Equipment**

Equipment Description and Estimated Fair Market Value.

- A. 1979 International Dump Truck, VIN AA182JHA21083, estimated value \$1,000 - \$2,000
- B. 1992 Elgin Street Sweeper, VIN J8DM7A1N4M3200346, estimated value \$3,000 - \$5,000
- C. John Deer Riding Mower, Model LA175, estimated value \$250 - \$500
- D. DR Home Leaf Vacuum, Model EX27, estimated value \$400 - \$800

The equipment listed within this resolution may be considered surplus equipment effective the date of adoption.

**Section II, Severability**


This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.
