The Month in Numbers:

Our pro-active Policing, which is a combination of traffic enforcement, emphasis patrols, etc. equals to 47% of the total incidents for the 1st half of April. This is having a direct effect in crime prevention as seen in incidents in the city and region as property crimes are low as are assaults. We are continuing emphasis patrols and traffic enforcement in the Gold Bar Region. We recently held a speed enforcement with our motorcycle unit on April 9th on Hwy 2 as well as Mann RD.



Highlight of Outstanding Police Work from this Month

Our pro-active Policing, accounted for 495 self-initiated incidents which is 42% of the total incidents. This is having a direct effect in crime prevention and the arrest of 14 different warrant subjects. The month of July was very busy as we handled over 583 calls made to the 911 center. In looking at the incidents we completed 58 case reports. Our response to BHC, welfare, suicide and death investigations were up. We have received traffic complaints about illegal ATV and dirt bikes operating on the public roadway. One of which led to an arrest for suspended license and impounding of the ATV. The city has put together a flier on what is required for ATV and or dirt bikes to be operated on the public roadway. If violators are contacted, they risk an infraction and or impound fees. We enjoyed participating in the Gold Bar Dust Days and the great conversations that were had.







Reminder of Rules for OVR(Off-Road-Vehicles) and WATV(Wheeled All-Terrain Vehicles) Inside the City of Gold Bar


With the weather warming, now is a good time to review the rules for OVR(Off-Road-Vehicles) and WATV(Wheeled All-Terrain Vehicles) inside the City of Gold Bar. Since June of 2019, WATVs have been allowed on city streets and inside city limits on US 2, where the speed limit does not exceed 35 MPH, as long as they meet the requirements listed in in Chapter 10.18 of the city municipal code at https://library.municode.com/.../codes/code of ordinances... If you operate a WATV on city streets, please adhere to the rules of the road, and share this information with anyone who might be unaware of the details. If you value the freedom provided by this ordinance, please familiarize yourself with the requirements so that it does not become a privilege the community is in danger of losing.

A partial list of requirements include:


- Legal WATVs must be registered and include an annual On-Road tab as listed and required in https://app.leg.wa.gov/RCW/default.aspx?cite=46.09
- Any wheeled all-terrain vehicle operated on a city street shall include the equipment listed in https://library.municode.com/.../codes/code of ordinances... including headlights, taillights, turn signals, etc.
- · Operators must be licensed drivers.
- Helmets are required for operators and passengers unless WATV is equipped with seat belts, roll bars, or enclosed passenger compartment.
- A person who operates a wheeled all-terrain vehicle shall carry proof of current liability insurance in compliance with, and with coverage limits at least equivalent to the amounts set forth in, https://app.leg.wa.gov/RCW/default.aspx?cite=46.29
- Riders must obey all traffic control devices and rules of the road.
- Drivers may not operate WATVs in a negligent or unsafe manner, may not tow anything behind the WATV, may not operate WATVs side by side in a single lane of traffic, and shall not carry passengers unless the WATV is equipped for passengers.
- WATVs may not be operated on sidewalks, in parks, on trails, bike paths, or anywhere operation of motorized vehicles is prohibited.
- WATVs are required to have an identifying flag as listed in the GBMC.













Harassment Cases ReportedDate w Time Month









Traffic Map





Count of IncidentNumber by IncidentType






Domestics in Beat GBR, regardless of ORI
















Monthly Report to the Community for April 2023

Highlight of Outstanding Police Work from this Month


Our pro-active Policing, which is a combination of traffic enforcement, emphasis patrols, etc. equals to 53% up from 48% in March. This is having a direct effect in crime prevention. 4 felony warrant arrests & 2 misdemeanor arrest. Located subject wanted for Assault 2 with a weapon. Emphasis patrol prevented illegal dumping at Gold Bar Grocer. Gold Bar Police participated in the Emergency Preparation Meeting held at Startup Center where the Chief talked about evacuations. We continue to work with Code Enforcement & Dept of Health on ordinance viol.








Incidents where the Beat is GBR, Regardless of ORI




Count of IncidentNumber by IncidentType




Incidents where the ORI Belongs to GBR PD Regardless of Location


