Monthly Report to the Community for February 2024

The Month in Numbers: 2/1 to 2/28/24

- 285 Incidents in the City of Gold Bar of which 184 were Officer Initiated
- 554 Incidents in the Gold Bar Region of which 286 were Officer Initiated

These incidents are being handled by a total staff of four Deputies and a Chief in an area of over 410 sq miles.

Highlight of Outstanding Police Work from this Month

For the month of February, the Gold Bar Police Department continues to be pro-active and responsive to issues not only in the City of Gold Bar, but also the Gold Bar Region. This month there were no reported burglaries, thefts, or vehicle prowls within the City of Gold Bar or in the Gold Bar Region.

Traffic enforcement remains a top priority for the Gold Bar Police Department. The Sheriff's Office Motors Unit spent time in and around the city on February 10th. We continue to work with our partner agencies including the Sultan Police Department and specialty units of the Sheriff's Office like our Motors Unit to be responsive to the needs of the community.

Additionally, the department will be participating in a new program called LEAD or Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion. This program is optional or at the discretion of the arresting deputy but gives the department another venue to refer subjects that have committed certain lower-level crimes to receive assistance or services versus being booked into the county jail.

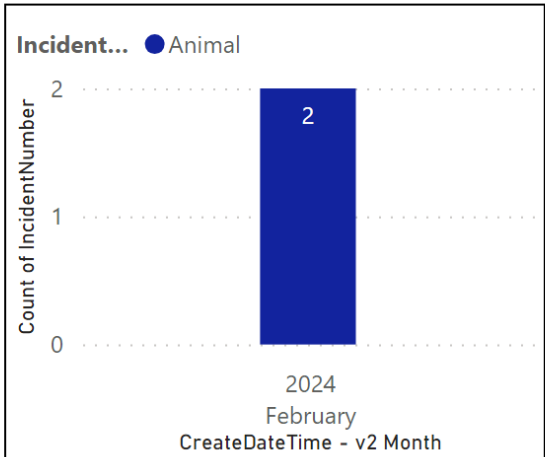
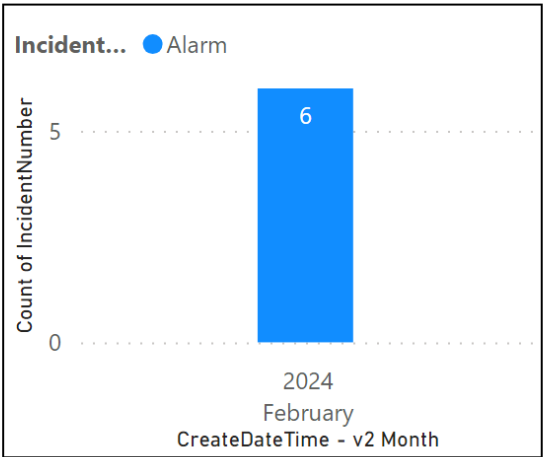
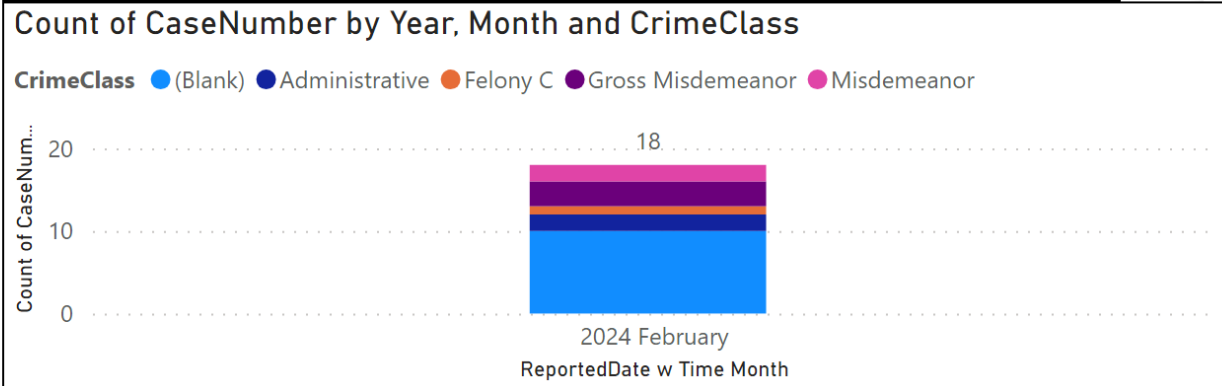
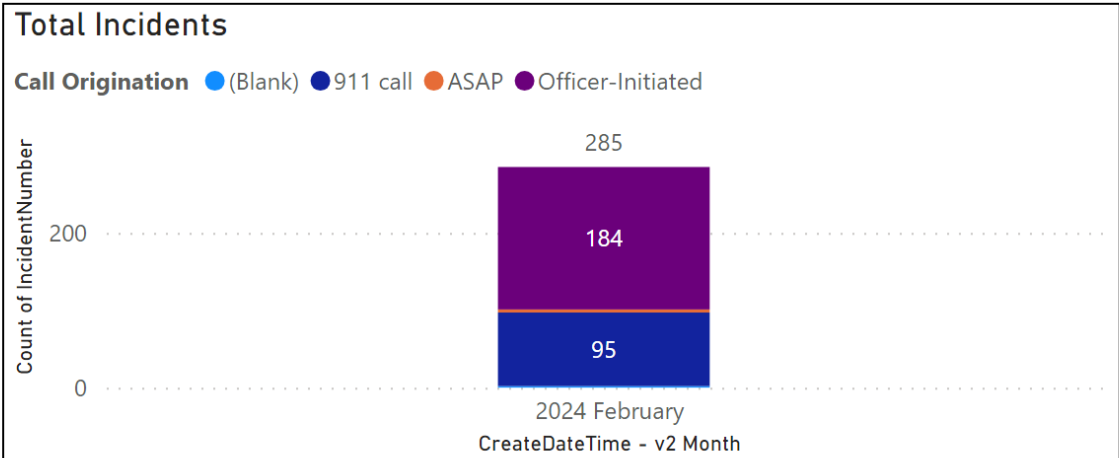

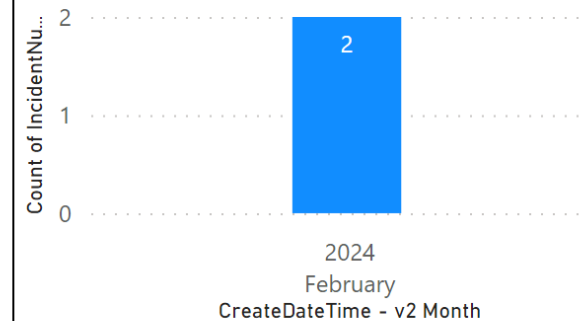

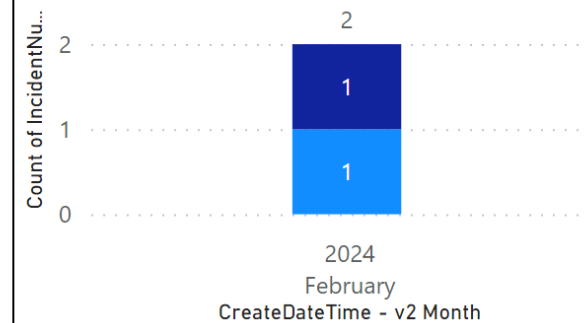

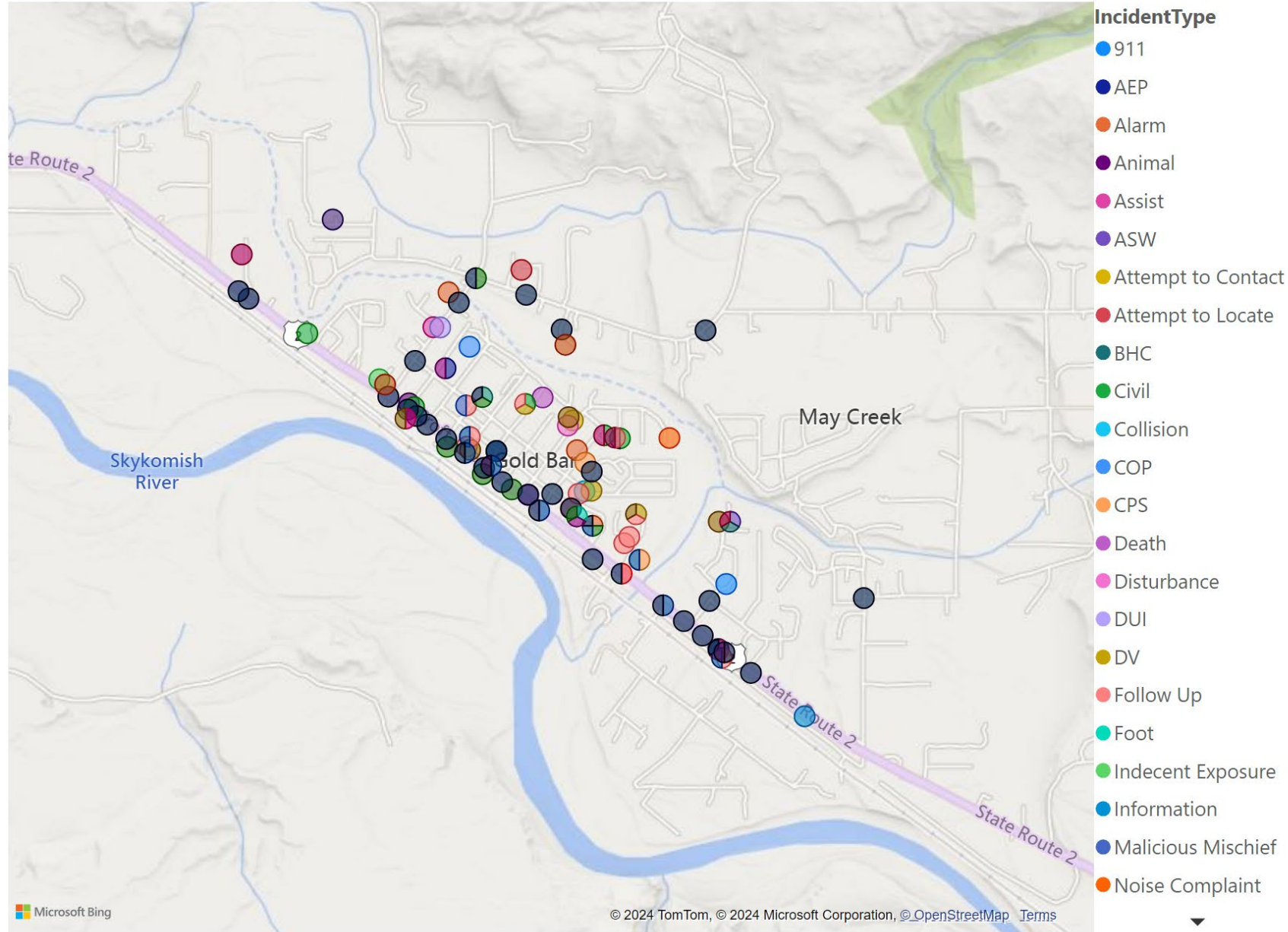

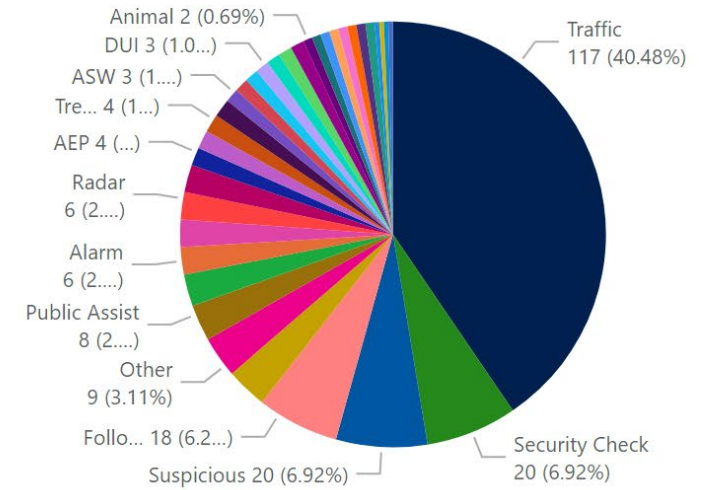

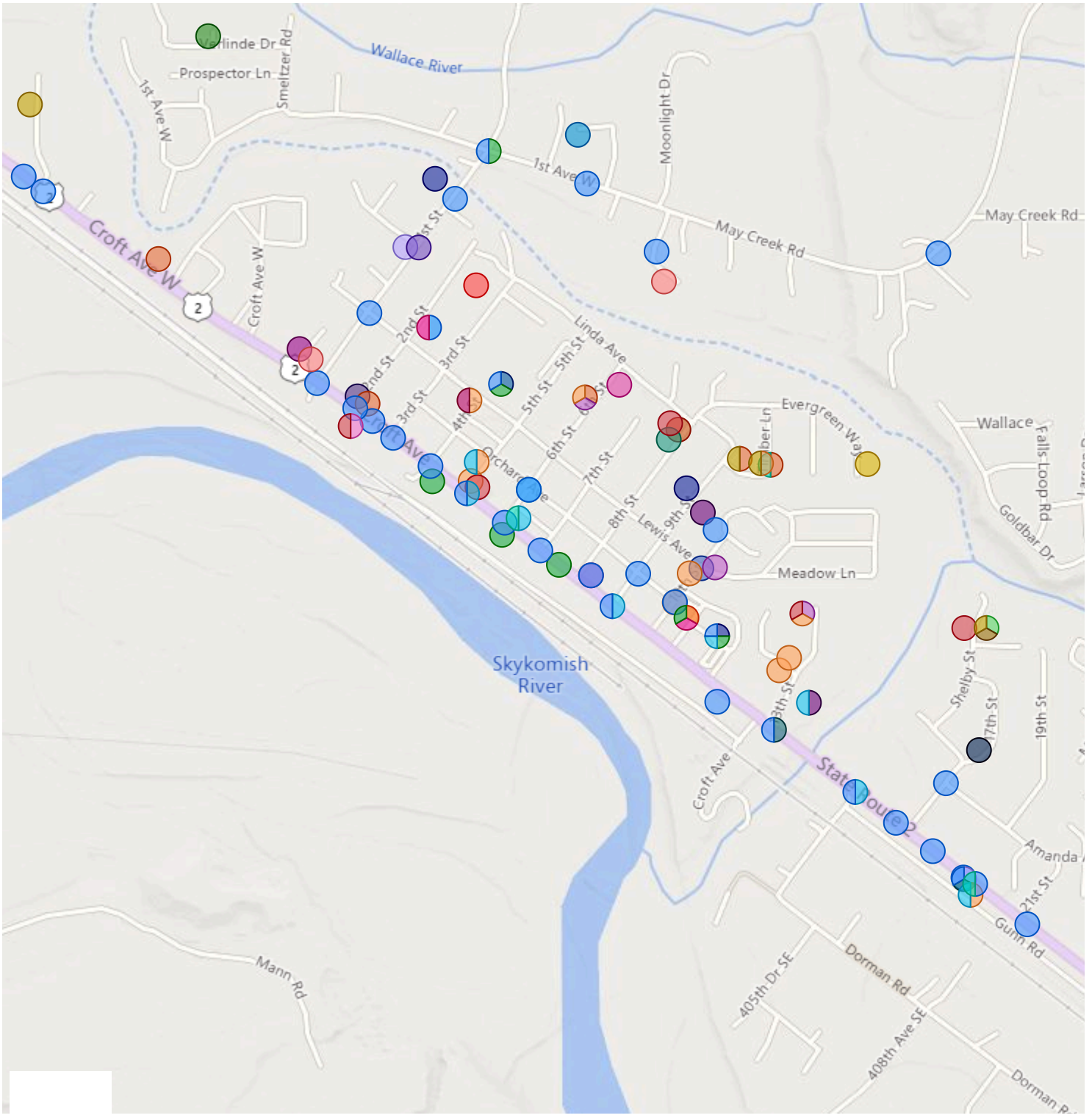

Count of IncidentNumber by IncidentType

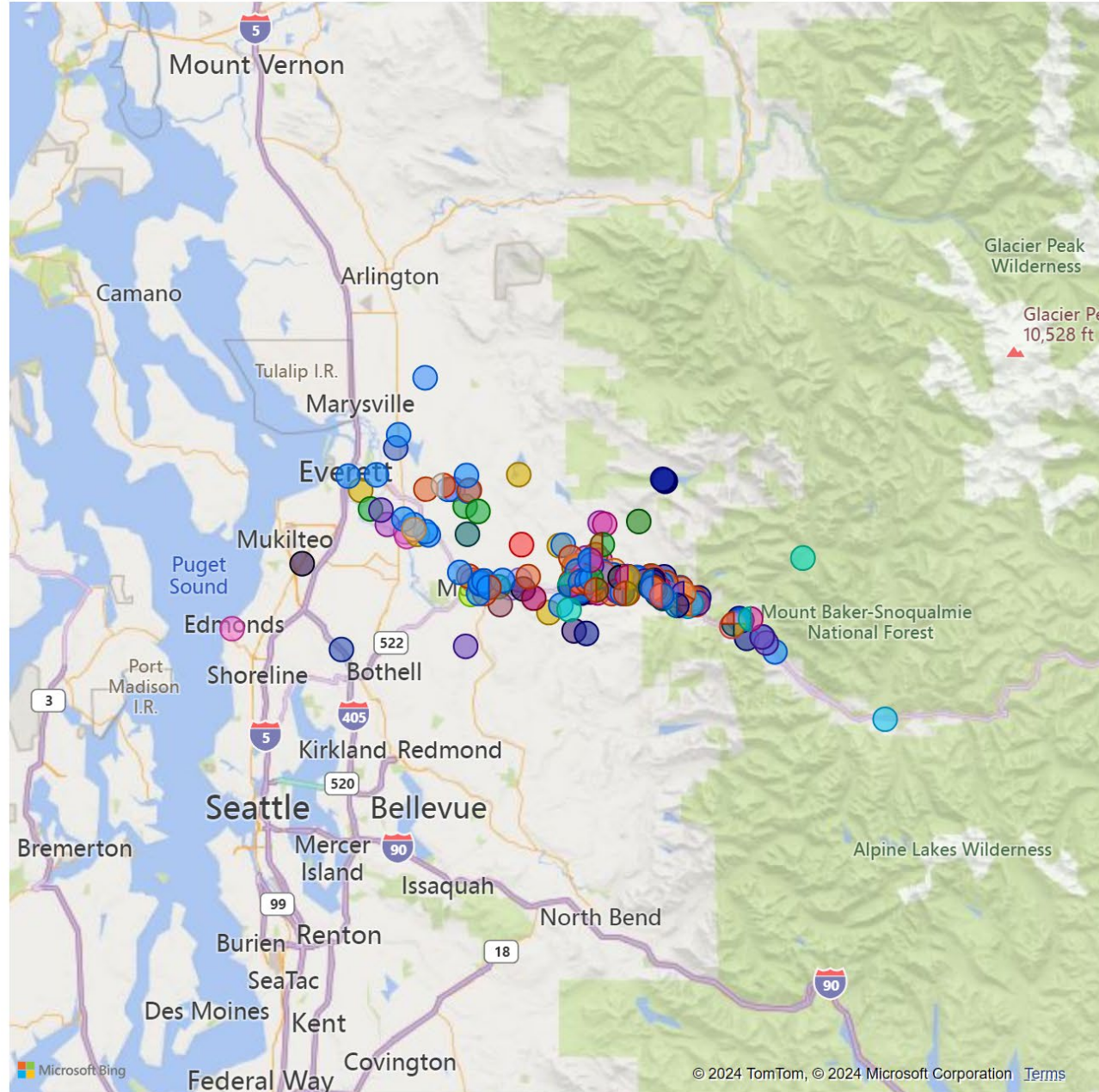




Incidents where the ORI Belongs to GBR PD Regardless of Location

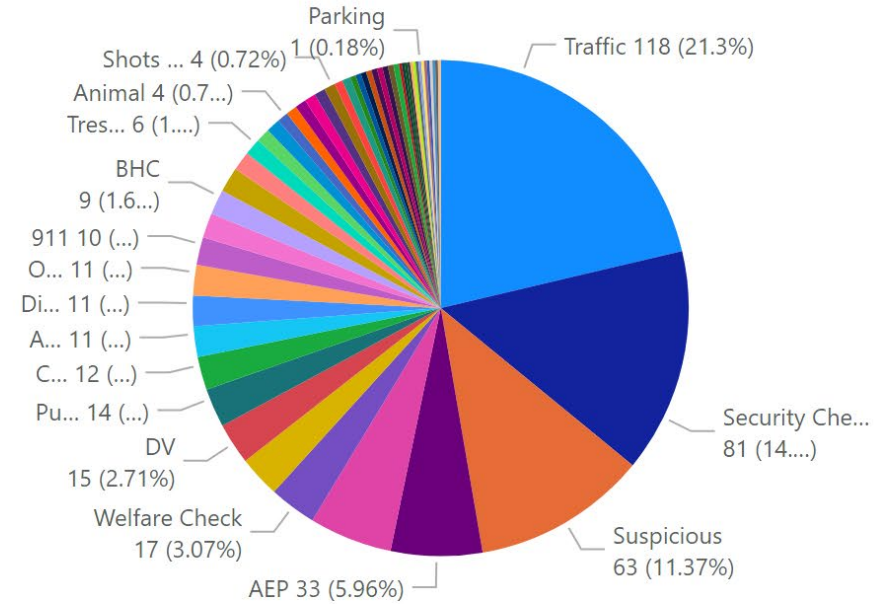

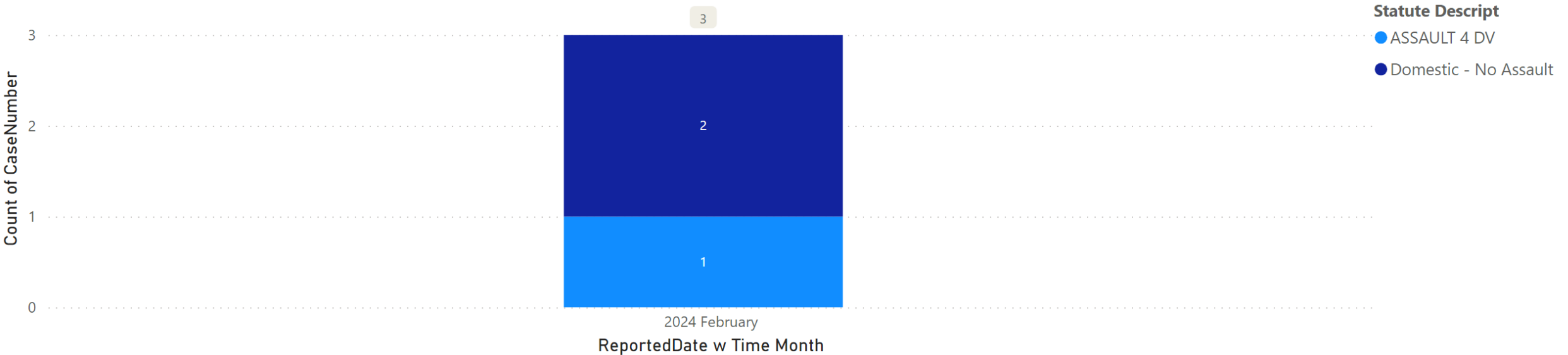
Count of IncidentNumber by IncidentType

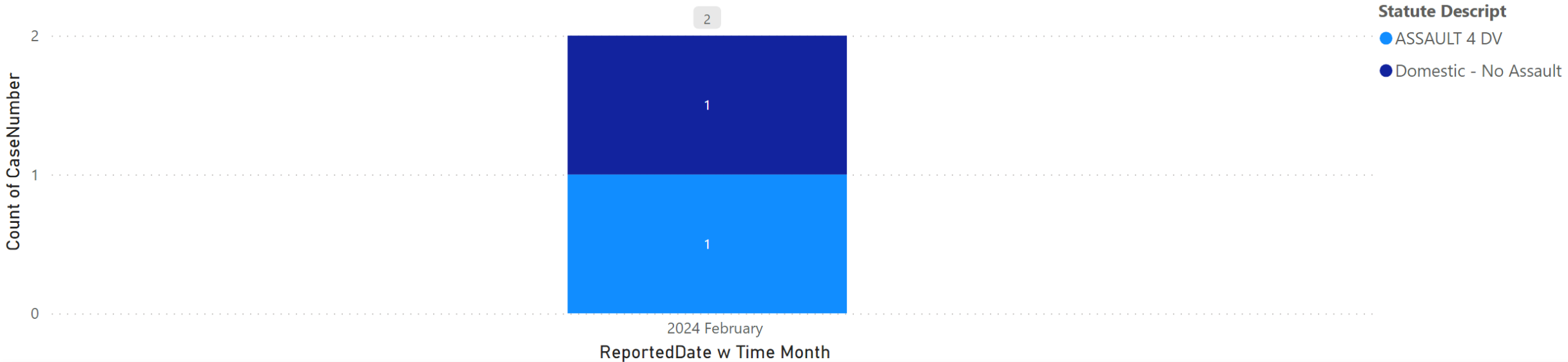
