**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLD BAR, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE**

**WHEREAS**, the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 42.56 prescribes fees allowed for public records; and

**WHEREAS**, those fees are part of the City's fee schedule; and

**WHEREAS**, the wording in the fee schedule could cause confusion;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the City of Gold Bar that the city's fee schedule be amended to clarify fees as follows.

**Section I, Title VIII. Administrative Fees**

**D. Document and public records costs and fees.**

**3. Paper copies:**

- a. Standard black and white photocopies or printed black and white copies (8.5 x 11): \$0.15 per page
- b. Color photocopies or printed color copies (8.5 x 11): \$0.15 per page
- c. Documents which must be copied by an outside source (ex. Comprehensive plans, code books, maps, irregular size records, photographs, etc.) will be charged based on the cost to the city for reproduction

**4. Scanned records:**

- a. Scanning records only available in electronic format, into paper copies: \$0.15 per page
- b. Scanning records only available in hard copy/paper records, into electronic format: \$0.10 per page

**Section IV, Severability**


This resolution is severable and if any portion of it shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portion shall remain valid and enforceable.
