Gold Bar Police Weekly Blotter: Weekly blotter from 11/18/24-11/24/24

Monday, November 18th:

- At 0915 hours, units responded to assist the Sultan Police Department on a Welfare Check in the 1100 block of Yew Way.
- At 2342 hours, units responded to a reported disturbance in the 300 block of 6th Street.

Tuesday, November 19th:

- At 0015 hours, units contacted an occupied suspicious vehicle in the city's dog park, located at 602 Croft Avenue. The occupants were advised the park was closed and were moved along.
- At 0128 hours, units responded to a traffic complaint in the 300 block of 6th Street for a speeding vehicle in the area. Units were unable to locate the vehicle.
- At 0543 hours, Gold Bar Police responded with the Sultan Police Department and SCSO deputies to a reported suicidal subject call. The involved subject was located and found deceased in the 36600 block of Kellogg Lake Road.
- At 1535 hours, units responded to an abandoned vehicle complaint in the 200 block of 19th Street.
- At 1716 hours, a Gold Bar Police vehicle was damaged while responding to a Search and Rescue call in the 38500 block of Sultan Basin Road. As the Gold Bar deputy was assisting stranded motorists a tree fell on the deputy's patrol vehicle. The Gold Bar deputy was outside of his vehicle at the time and was uninjured.
- At 2049 hours, units responded to a traffic complaint in the area of 4th Street and Croft Avenue for a speeding vehicle.

Wednesday, November 20th:

- At 1131 hours, units responded to a suspicious complaint at the intersection of 1st Street and Croft Avenue.
- At 1317 hours, units received a follow up request regarding the earlier suspicious complaint at 1st Street and Croft Avenue.
- At 1602 hours, units responded to a traffic hazard complaint for a tree down in the 16600 block of 415th Avenue SE.

Thursday, November 21st:

- At 1050 hours, units responded to a parking complaint in the 200 block of 19th Street.
- At 1158 hours, units observed a suspicious subject in the 300 block of 1st Street and attempted to contact them. However, the subject took off running. Since there was no crime being committed, deputies did not engage in a foot pursuit.
- At 1222 hours, units responded to a suspicious complaint in the 100 block of 6th Street.
- At 1231 hours, units responded to a cold theft complaint for a stolen bicycle from the 200 block of 7th Street.
- At 2018 hours, units responded to a found property complaint in the 1100 block of Croft Avenue.

- At 1300 hours, units observed a suspicious vehicle in the area of 19th Street and Aaron Avenue.
- At 1359 hours, units responded to a death investigation in the 200 block of 9th Street.

Saturday, November 23rd:

-At 0305 hours, Gold Bar Police responded to assist SCSO-South Precinct deputies on a burglary in progress in the 21100 block of State Route 9 SE, located in unincorporated Woodinville. A commercial business had been broken into and there were several suspects per the alarm company. Mutual Aid was requested from several agencies to include Bothell, Gold Bar, Mill Creek, Washington State Patrol, and Woodinville.

Upon arrival, the suspects fled in a vehicle and a pursuit was initiated by an outside agency. However, the pursuit was terminated by that agency and the suspects were not apprehended. The investigation is on-going.

Sunday, November 24th:

- At 0158 hours, Gold Bar Police responded to a help the officer call in the 14100 block of 278th Avenue NE, located in the City of Duvall. According to the King County Sheriff's Office, a deputy was fighting with a suicidal subject. Units were canceled prior to arrival.
- At 1111 hours, units responded to an ordinance violation at May Creek Road and Ley Road.
- At 2240 hours, units responded to the 300 block of 6th Street for a noise complaint.
