Gold Bar Police Weekly Blotter: Weekly blotter from 12/16/24-12/22/24

Monday, December 16th:

-At 0022 hours, units responded to a domestic violence situation in the 200 block of May Lane. Upon arrival, probable cause was established for Assault 4th Degree DV. However, the suspect in the incident initially refused to surrender or exit the residence. It was believed the suspect was armed with a firearm, so Region 1 SWAT was consulted.

Fortunately, the suspect complied prior to SWAT's arrival and was taken into custody without incident. Region 1 SWAT is comprised of deputies and officers from SCSO, Everett PD, and Lake Stevens PD. Monroe PD's K-9 unit also assisted in this incident.

-At 1203 hours, units responded to a residential alarm in the 700 block of Verlinde Avenue. The alarm was found to be a false alarm.

-At 1257 hours, units handled a follow up request from Dick's Towing regarding a towed vehicle.

-At 1445 hours, a SCSO Civil Deputy served court paperwork in the 500 block of Croft Avenue W.
