Gold Bar Police Weekly Blotter: **Weekly blotter from 12/23/24-12/29/24**

Monday, December 23rd:

- At 0532 hours, units responded to a suspicious vehicle complaint in the 300 block of Tweit Court.
- At 0627 hours, units contacted a subject sleeping in their vehicle near the intersection of 6th Street and Orchard Avenue.
- At 0714 hours, units assisted SCSO with a single vehicle collision at High Bridge Road and Crescent Lake Road.
- At 1004 hours, units responded to a malicious mischief complaint at the Gold Bar Dog Park.
- At 2346 hours, units contacted an occupied suspicious vehicle in the Alder Lane development.

Tuesday, December 24th:

- At 0004 hours, units responded to assist the Sultan Police Department on a physical domestic in the 1100 block of Yew Avenue. Upon arrival and after investigation, an adult female was taken into custody and booked into the Snohomish County Jail.
- At 0721 hours, units responded to an illegal dumping incident at the Gold Bar Dog Park. The report was received by Gold Bar Public Works. Deputies responded and contacted the involved subject, who picked up the items.

Wednesday, December 25th:

- At 0140 hours, units responded to reported shooting in the 100 block of Croft Avenue W. The suspect, a 58 year old male, shot a 48 year old male during an argument and then fled on foot.

Mutual Aid was requested from multiple agencies to include the Arlington Police (K-9 Unit), Mill Creek Police, Monroe Police, SCSO, Snohomish Police, Sultan Police, and the Washington State Patrol. A Police K-9 was deployed along with a drone. Unfortunately, the suspect was not located at that time.

However, with the assistance from our Violent Offender Task Force (VOTF) the suspect was located and taken into custody without incident the following day on 12/26. The suspect was booked into the Snohomish County Jail for Assault 1st Degree and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.

- At 0903 hours, units responded to a nuisance complaint at Dorman Road and State Route 2.
- At 1555 hours, units responded to two vehicle collision in the 40700 block of State Route 2.
- At 1808 hours, Gold Bar Police responded to assist SCSO with a recklessly driven vehicle at Mile Post 18 on State Route 2. SCSO terminated the pursuit, and the suspect vehicle was not located.
