

Gold Bar Police Department

Monthly Report to the Community for March 2025

The Month in Numbers: 3/1 to 3/31/25

- 256 Incidents in the City of Gold Bar of which 123 were deputy initiated.
- 466 Incidents in the Gold Bar Region of which 216 were deputy initiated.
- 722 Incidents for the month of March.
- 23 Incidents per day on average

These incidents are being handled by a total staff of four Deputies and a Chief in an area of over 410 sq miles.






Highlights of the Gold Bar Police Department from this Month:


For the month of March, Gold Bar Region deputies continue to prioritize traffic safety issues particularly on State Route 2 between Gold Bar and Sultan city limits. Region deputies issued illegal passing infractions in the Startup community and continue to work with Sultan PD along with the Washington State Patrol to combat reports of reckless driving or road rage incidents.


Additionally, the Gold Bar Police Department assisted with the removal of an illegally parked motorhome from city limits and continue to address other quality of life issues in the city. This can be observed from the proactivity efforts of the department this month. For example, nearly half of all calls for service or incidents were deputy initiated this month within the city limits.




































Gold Bar Incident Types - Past 12 Full Calendar Months




Count of IncidentNumber by IncidentType




Incidents where the ORI Belongs to GBR PD Regardless of Location

Gold Bar ORI, Previous 12 full calendar months





Domestics in Beat GBR, regardless of ORI




